The best way to predict the future is to create it. One of my favorite success stories this year is of two seniors, Chris and Anthony, not on track to graduate with their class. They were failing and were close to giving up. But our Career Counselor, Ms. Laura, thought of a solution. What if we pulled Chris and Anthony out of high school and enrolled them in a career online high school? If they completed the curriculum before the end of the school year, they would be able to walk with their graduating class and receive their diplomas. Ms. Laura got the green light from the School District to go ahead with the plan. She met extensively with the boys' parents and drew up a contract of expectations for all parties involved.

Every day, they came to the Vero Beach Club and worked for hours on the online curriculum. Chris and Anthony finally had someone in their corner and it kept them going. On May 15th, both boys graduated with their class. Chris and Anthony refer to that day as one of the best in their lives.

Chris plans to pursue his AA degree at Polk State College, and Anthony plans on joining the Army. Even though the boys are no longer Club members, Ms. Laura is protecting our investment by helping the boys transition to the next phase of their lives.

Sometimes the impact we have on the kids is not readily apparent. In this case, it is gratifying to know that the boys have plans for the future thanks to the Destinations program. **It's possible because of your support. Thank you.**

ABOUT OUR CLUBS

We first opened our doors inside a small classroom of a local elementary school in the year 2000. Since then, we have grown to serve more than 1,000 registered members annually and hundreds of additional children through community outreach. We operate three Clubhouses, one each in Vero Beach, Sebastian and Fellsmere. The Sebastian Club opened in 2006, followed by the Vero Beach and Fellsmere Clubs in 2010. The Clubs include education and technology centers with computers, art and game rooms, teen centers, outdoor green space, and multipurpose areas.

We are open every day after school and all day during summer and school breaks, providing a vital service to our county's children and families. The rate of juvenile crime more than doubles between the non-school hours of 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m., and it is during those hours that children are more likely to be involved in substance abuse and risky behaviors. The Clubs offer a safe, positive, and educational environment for our community's youth, encouraging them to achieve their highest potential.

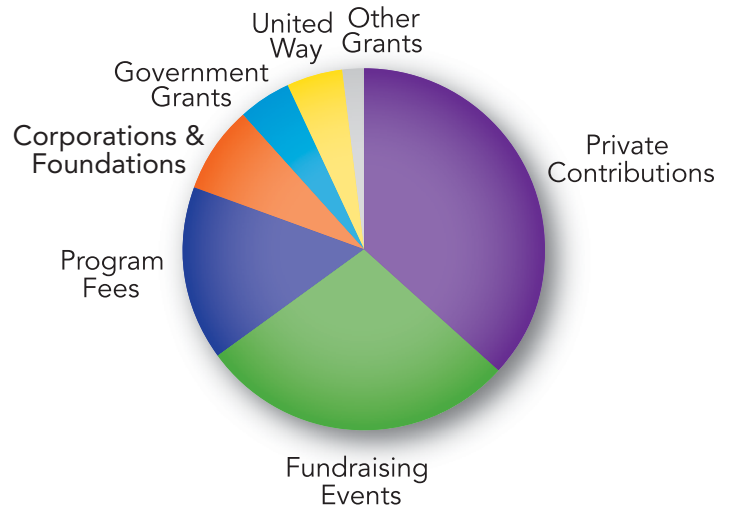

2018-2019 Fiscal Year Operating Overview*

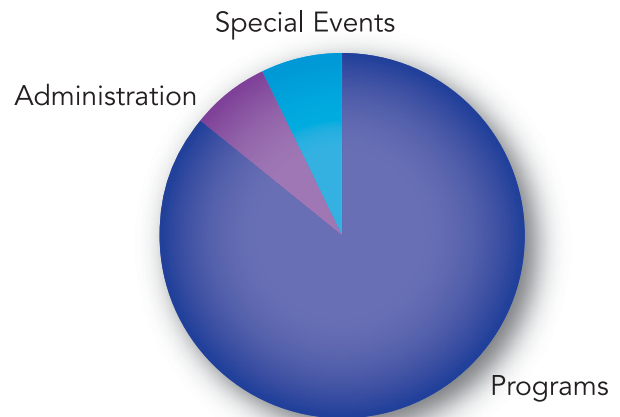

A transformational college and career preparatory program for teens ages 13-18. Activities include college tours, guest speakers, internships with local businesses, resume writing, and leadership workshops. Teens work with a full-time Career Counselor to identify potential career paths, develop key life skills, and uncover various community, college and vocational opportunities.



Athletics

Club members participate in a wide range of sports and physical activities to embrace healthy lifestyles and develop teamwork and self-confidence. We currently offer basketball, flag football, soccer, swimming through Float Hope, rowing, and an adventure endurance program that includes rock climbing and mountain biking.

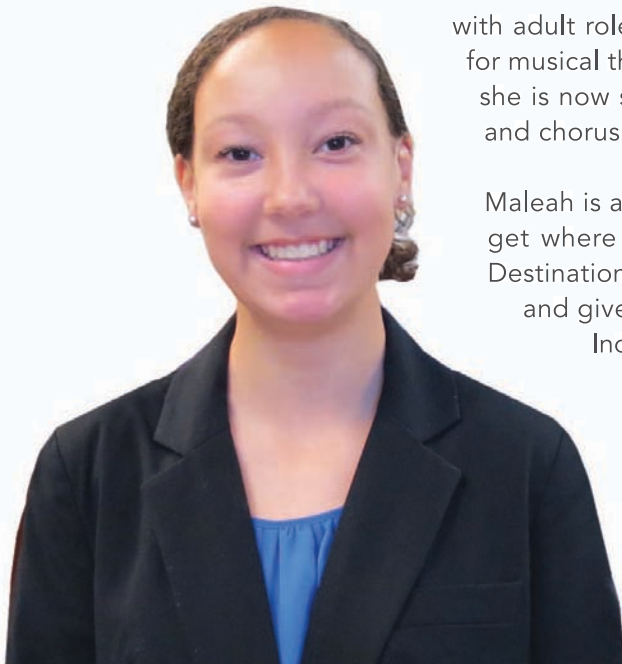
